



Assignment Deadline, Extension Requests

- 15 days from the date of last class
 - 2359 SG time
- Any extensions is strictly at the <u>discretion of the University</u>
- Extension request to be submitted to studentsuccess@ags.edu.sg at least 3 working days prior to the deadline, along with supporting documents (Medical Certs, etc.)
- Reasons such as the following are not valid grounds for an extension request:
 - Work commitments
 - Failure to attend class
 - Computer failure/ technical issue
 - Outstation for work
 - Personal travel

No formal extension of assignment submission deadline (s) unless it has written approval from Aventis.





Late Submissions

- Penalty will be imposed on work that is submitted after the stipulated deadline
- Penalties are as follows:
 - For submissions up to 2359 (SG time), seven calendar days after deadline; grades will be capped at <u>50%</u>
 - For submission after 2359 (SG time), seven calendar days after the deadline; the assessment will be set to **zero**






Marking Process

• There are 4 stages of marking for your programme:

 Grades will be confirmed at the exam board that takes place at the University.



 Provisional results of assignments will be released in Moodle one month after the assignment due date





Provisional Results

- Provisional results of assignments will be released on Moodle one month after the assignment due date.
- Actual results of assignment will be confirmed during the University's Assessment board.
- Students will be informed of any re-assessments/re-module if required.





Re-sit & Re-modules

Exam Board

• Outcome (fail) from after the University exam board

Re-sit

- You will be permitted one opportunity to attempt the assignment without having to attend classes
- A re-sit fee of \$535 (Inc GST) will be applicable

Re-takes

- Student who fail the re-sit opportunity will be required to attend classes again at the next opportunity it is being offered
- Re-module fee will be based on your signed student contract





Certificate & Transcripts

- You can expect to receive your certificate and transcript 4 months after the confirmation of your results by the University Exam Board
- We will send out emails to invite students to come by for collection of your certificate and transcript
- For overseas students, we can courier you the Certificate through registered mail. (courier charges applies)







Classification of Results / Sample Certificates

*** Name are printed on certificate and transcripts based on official documents such as NRIC and passports.

- On transcripts, module results will display grades
- On certificates will display the classification based on average mark
- Pass: 50% 59%
- Merit: 60% 69%
- Distinction: 70% 100%

Deferment Policy
